"Van Gogh considered this impressive vista as one of his finest works. The colours of the southern French countryside in summer dominate this painting: the warm yellowy-gold of the wheat and azure green of the shimmering light. The painting shows the plain of La Crau, outside Arles, with in the distance the Alpilles mountain range. For the foreground Van Gogh used touches of paint in various directions, while for the background he applied more uniform colour patches, thereby creating extra depth."



Reception of New Members & the Sacrament of Baptism

In today's service, we publicly receive Jesse, Chauntel, and Penelope Mancuso as members of Hershey PCA. Jesse and Penelope will receive the sacrament of baptism. This sacrament was instituted by Christ. As this sign and seal is applied, we remember Jesus's instructions to us: "And Jesus came and said to them, 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹ Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.'" (Matthew 28:18-20)

Declaration of Admission:

As an applicant for admission into the Church of God by Baptism, which is a sign and seal of our engrafting into Christ, and of our engagement to be the Lord's, and into the membership of Hershey PCA, the Session has examined and approved **Jesse Mancuso**, who is cordially welcomed into the fellowship of the household of faith and into the fellowship of Hershey PCA.

As an applicant for admission into the membership of Hershey PCA by reaffirmation of faith, having previously been baptized into the Triune Name of God, the Session has examined and approved **Chauntel Mancuso**, who is cordially welcomed into the fellowship of Hershey PCA.

Profession of Faith (Questions for Membership)*

Both of you being here present to make a public profession of your faith, are to assent to the following declarations and promises, by which you enter into a solemn covenant with God and His Church.

- 1. Do you acknowledge yourself to be a sinner in the sight of God, justly deserving His displeasure, and without hope save in His sovereign mercy?
- 2. Do you believe in the Lord Jesus Christ as the Son of God, and Savior of sinners, and do you receive and rest upon Him alone for salvation as He is offered in the Gospel?
- 3. Do you now resolve and promise, in humble reliance upon the grace of the Holy Spirit, that you will endeavor to live as becomes the followers of Christ?
- 4. Do you promise to support the Church in its worship and work to the best of your ability?
- 5. Do you submit yourselves to the government and discipline of the Church, and promise to study its purity and peace?

Question to the Congregation:

Do you as a congregation welcome Jesse & Chauntel into the fellowship of the church as a brother and sister in Christ and fellow citizens in the kingdom of God's Beloved Son? (Colossians 1:13-14)

Exhortation to the parents in presenting their child Penelope Lou for baptism: *

Reading the Covenant Promises: *

Genesis 17:7: "And I will establish my covenant between me and you and your offspring after you throughout their generations for an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and to your offspring after you."

Acts 2:39: "For the promise is for you and for your children and for all who are far off, everyone whom the Lord our God calls to himself."

Acts 16:31: "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household."

Questions for the parents: *

- 1. Do you acknowledge your child's need of the cleansing blood of Jesus Christ, and the renewing grace of the Holy Spirit?
- 2. Do you claim God's covenant promises in her behalf, and do you look in faith to the Lord Jesus Christ for his salvation, as you do for your own?
- 3. Do you now unreservedly dedicate your child to God, and promise, in humble reliance upon divine grace, that you will endeavor to set before her a godly example, that you will pray with and for her, that you will teach her the doctrines of our holy religion, and that you will strive, by all the means of God's appointment, to bring her up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord?

Question for the congregation: *

Do you as a congregation undertake the responsibility of assisting the parents in the Christian nurture of this child?


